

Community Education Forums to be Held

The Connecticut River Collaborative Committee was developed after each town, at their annual 2018 March meeting, voted to examine the future of education in this region. The committee is composed of members representing each area community and their respective school boards as well as the superintendents of SAU 7 and the Canaan & NEK Choice school districts. After examining 23 possible alternatives, the committee agreed that one model stood out among the rest as the obvious educational alternative to bring forward to community members for further review.

In an effort to build uniform understanding, four regional forums have been designed to give community members the opportunity to identify essential questions and concerns to be addressed in the months ahead. Community members can attend any one or all of the forums listed below. The meetings are intended to be similar in nature and not specific to the hosting town.
